In Summer 2018, SIMMER began app development of Hungry4Halal, a mobile application connecting users with halal cuisine through recipes, restaurant mapping and engaging video content.

This culturally based app is currently being created by students whom are underrepresented in the tech world, mainly young Muslim women along with a diverse and talented crew including veterans and tech mavens. Students are learning to build a functional app launching late July 2018. They are gaining a deeper understanding of programming language and familiarizing themselves with the many valuable features of code development and the integrated development environment (IDE). They are also gathering and creating all app content, marketing and launching the application—all in one entrepreneurial filled summer!
